Custom Type Y "Duquesne" Class Hunting Yacht

The information below is for the Scrying Eye Games product 'Custom Type Y "Duquesne' Class Hunting Yacht" deckplans, available either in print at http://www.rpgnow.com. or in PDF format at http://www.rpgnow.com.

A major contributor and alumni of a certain subsector university required a specialized starship that he could use to travel Known Space in search of new and exotic species. His grants and social status allowed him to "commission" a ship design from that university's Department of Naval Architectural Engineering. He required a ship that could transport himself and a seasoned team for the purpose of capturing and transporting live animals for biological and zoological study. Taking a standard Type Y Yacht and Ship's Boat, the university customized the Duquesne Class, listed below.

Since the ship was designed using grant money, the contributor had the Duquesne Class blueprints granted the legal classification of Imperial Creative Common, hence classifying them as a "Standard Design" for all Imperial citizens at the usual 10% off standard shipyard production costs.
